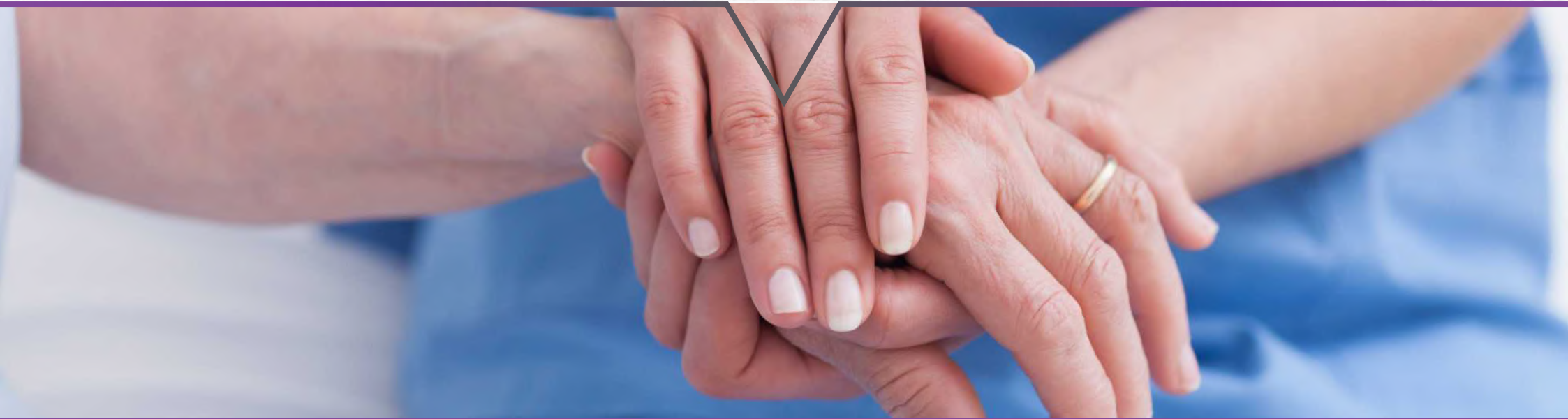

Osaka is Japan's second biggest metropolitan zone after Tokyo. It has been the financial powerhouse of the Kansai Region for a long time. Osaka was once in the past known as Naniwa. Prior to the Nara Period, when the capital used to be moved with the rule of each new head, Naniwa was at one time Japan's capital city, the first historically speaking known. In the 16th century, Toyotomi Hideyoshi picked Osaka as the area for his stronghold, and the city may have turned into Japan's political capital if Tokugawa Ieyasu had not ended the Toyotomi heredity after Hideyoshi's passing and moved his administration to inaccessible Edo (Tokyo).

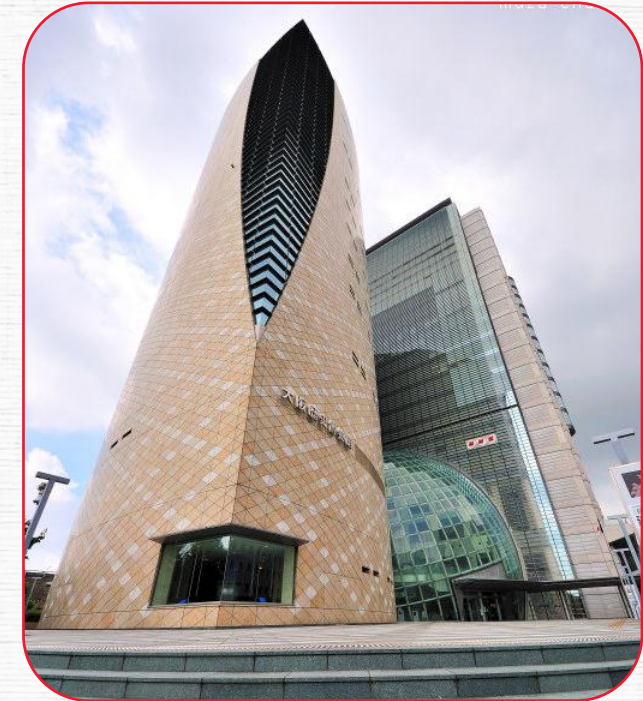
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
