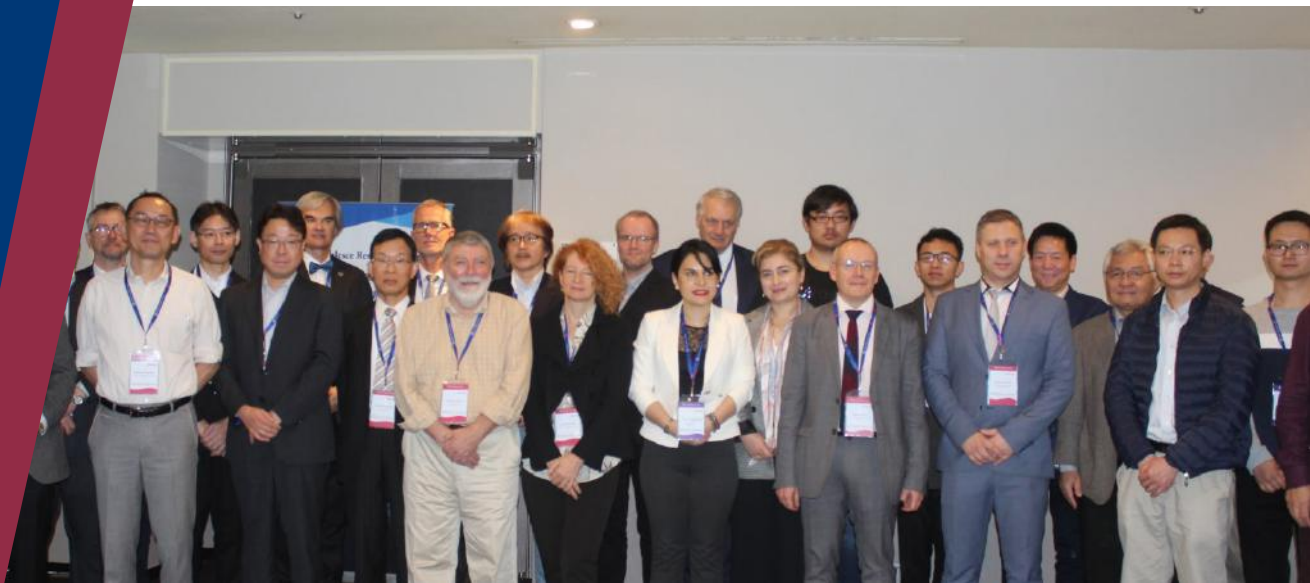

Learning Pathways

Educational Workshops/ Research Workshops/Corporate Workshops/ Mini- Symposia/Special Session:

With an aim of transferring knowledge among the participants, workshops are introduced as a part of international conferences. These interactive and occasionally practical sessions give an opportunity for participants to engage in detail discussion. Workshops are mostly scheduled for 60 to 90-minutes. It may range from learning about a specific topic relevant to international education, products and research which sometimes involves practical demonstration. It helps in enhancing skills, knowledge and understanding of the research field in depth through interactive discussions.

The most successful workshops are highly interactive and address innovative ideas and learner-centered needs. Major criteria for workshop selection include:

- A topic that is timely and important for the intended audience
- The innovativeness of the proposal
- Learning objectives that are clear and appropriate
- The skill and expertise of the leaders
- A format that is likely to be interactive and attractive for participants
- The appropriateness of the topic to academic pediatricians and pediatricians-in-training

While the format may vary, workshops should be designed to facilitate discussions between workshop leaders and participants. The workshop may include a short didactic presentation, but the overall intention of these sessions is to actively involve the attendees in the learning process. Workshop leaders and participants should be prepared to jointly dive into this cooperative venture! The average workshop size is 20 to 30 participants.
